Interior Cleaning & Disinfecting

Champion Coach is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for customers. Please review our interior cleaning and disinfecting procedure overview below.

Color Coded Rag System

Champion Coach has implemented a color-coded cleaning and disinfecting rag system which is an industry standard across hotel, restaurant and other industries. This system ensures rags used to clean hazard areas such as floors, footrests and stairwells do not contaminate critical high traffic touch areas such as handrails, tray tables and arm rests. Clean rags are used during each interior cleaning. Rags are not recycled across multiple interior cleanings. Used rags are placed in designated bins for washing with hot water, industrial detergent and disinfecting solution. Colors are never mixed during wash cycles to avoid contamination.

General Interior Cleaning

Prior to every departure, a deep clean is performed on the interior of each coach. Dust and debris are removed by vacuuming and supplemental sweeping. Once the cabin is free of dust and debris, our teams wipe down critical high traffic touch areas such as, but not limited to, handrails, overhead bin doors and handles, overhead reading light buttons and air vents, windows, passenger seats, seat belts, arm rests, tray tables, power outlets and driver's area. Floors are then cleaned with a warm water and disinfectant solution. The final step in the cleaning process is fogging with an EPA registered disinfectant.

Lavatory

The lavatory is cleaned and disinfected during every coach cleaning. Lavatory holding tank contents are disposed in an EPA certified waste treatment site. Every surface in the lavatory such as door handles, handrails, toilet seat and surrounding areas are wiped down with disposable one time use wipes and/or paper products. Color coded rags and/or reusable rags are prohibited to reduce contamination of other surfaces throughout the cabin. The lavatory is fogged as part of the final cleaning procedure.



Fogging

Champion Coach utilizes electric handheld electrostatic and atomized fogging devices to provide the highest level of interior disinfecting. All interior areas such as the lavatory, cabin, driver's area and cargo areas below the cabin where luggage is stored is fogged prior to departure and is the final step in the cleaning process. Champion Coach utilizes a safe, high-grade EPA-registered disinfectant that is highly effective against many communicable diseases including coronaviruses used by airlines such as United, Southwest, JetBlue and more.

HVAC Systems

Heating and Air Conditioning systems are critical to the safety and comfort of our customers and operators. While Champion Coach has always changed, cleaned and serviced system components such as filters and ducts frequently, we have proactively increased the frequency of system services which includes filter changes. Interior fogging disinfectants are introduced to the system prior to every departure. UV light disinfection systems and/or MERV-13 filters are also being installed in compatible equipment which eliminates 99% of microbial contaminants in the cabin and continues too for the duration of your trip.

Onboard Hand Sanitation

Hand sanitizer dispensers have previously only been found in the lavatory. We have proactively added additional dispensers at the front of the coach for immediate hand sanitation when boarding the coach. Hand sanitizers onboard are professional grade and have no less than 60% active ingredients of ethanol and/or ethyl alcohol in accordance with CDC recommendations.

In Route Cleaning

Our driver's primary responsibility is the safety of passengers onboard. Each bus is equipped with a cleaning kit used for standard cleaning and disinfecting. The driver will wipe down critical high traffic touch points such as handrails with disinfectant as needed.

Luggage Bays

Areas below the cabin used to store luggage, equipment and other cargo are equally as important as the cabin above. Prior to each departure, luggage bays are cleaned and fogged with disinfectant.



Cleaning Chemical & Disinfectant List

These products have been tested by our team to ensure no negative effects on passengers, operators, interior materials and components. All products are professional, industrial and/or hospital grade for the health and safety of our customers and operators.
